2019 Annual Crime Stoppers Golf Tournament

The Community First Bank 2019 Crime Stoppers of Oconee County, Inc. Golf Tournament is now just two weeks away.

The Community First Bank 2019 Crime Stoppers Golf Tournament will take place at the beautiful Oconee Country Club, a par-71, 6,051 yard course on Friday, May 3rd. Registration will begin at 8am and will have a 9am shotgun start. Oconee Country Club is located at 781 Richland Road in Seneca.

Community First Bank will be the title sponsor for this year's tournament. Oconee Federal Savings & Loan will be sponsoring our BBQ lunch. We would also like to welcome our new sponsor The Lake, WSNW Radio Station.

The cost per player is \$60 or \$240 for a team. Mulligans will be sold at two for \$10.

Hole sponsorships are available for \$100 or \$150.

Sponsors at the \$150 level will have their sponsorship signs displayed not only at the golf tournament, but also at the 15th Annual Crime Stoppers Apple Festival Car Show which will be held on September 7, 2019 in Westminster during the 2019 South Carolina Apple Festival. There will be goodie bags supplied by McDaniel Supply Company and door prizes from many other local businesses.

A big part of the tournament is the \$25,000 prize for anyone who scores a hole-in-one on the 14th hole. A longest drive contest will be held on the par-5 8th hole and a closest to the pin contest will be held on the par-3 6th hole.
